

Rating Action: Moody's Ratings assigns Aa3 ENH to Fort Sumner Mun. School District No. 20, NM's GO bonds

New York, July 30, 2024 -- Moody's Ratings (Moody's) has assigned a Aa3 enhanced rating to Fort Sumner Municipal School District No. 20, NM's General Obligation School Bonds, Series 2024 in the estimated par amount of \$2 million. The district has roughly \$3 million of GOULT (general obligation unlimited tax) debt outstanding.

RATINGS RATIONALE

The Aa3 enhanced rating is based on our assessment of the New Mexico (Aa2 stable) School District Intercept Program and a review of the district's proposed financing. In order to qualify for the programmatic rating of Aa3, per our methodology, annual debt service coverage must be at least sum sufficient. In Fort Sumner Municipal School District No. 20's case, coverage is ample at more than nine times, based on fiscal 2023 state aid. LEGAL SECURITY

The bonds are general obligations backed by the district's full faith and credit and are payable from ad valorem taxes to be levied against all taxable property within the district, without limitation as to rate or amount. The bonds are further payable by the state's commitment to pay debt service, if necessary, pursuant to the New Mexico School District Intercept Program.

USE OF PROCEEDS

Proceeds from the Series 2024 bonds will fund improvements to the district's facilities, including teacher housing, and technology upgrades.

PROFILE

Fort Sumner Municipal School District No. 20 is in central New Mexico, approximately 140 miles east of Albuquerque, NM (Aa3 stable). The district serves approximately 260 students.
